



**Union Medical Healthcare temporarily suspends beauty services to comply with government measures to prevent spread of disease**

**The company's medical services continue as normal as registered doctors fulfil duties to fight against epidemic**

(8 April 2020, Hong Kong) – **Union Medical Healthcare Limited** (“Union Medical Healthcare” or the “Company”, which together with its subsidiaries, is referred to as the “Group”; SEHK stock code: 2138), the leading integrated medical group in Hong Kong, responded to the government’s call and is in compliance with the relevant regulations and laws for temporary closure of beauty parlours to prevent the spread of COVID-19. The decree takes effect from 00:00 a.m. on 10 April 2020. The Group will temporarily suspend its beauty services accordingly. As a professional medical organization, Union Medical Healthcare continues its medical services as normal amid the epidemic. Registered doctors perform their duties at the Group’s clinics.

To safeguard the safety of customers and employees during the epidemic, the Group’s clinics and service centres have already implemented a series of hygiene and preventive measures, including compulsory checks on the body temperature of visitors and patients before their entrance, the provision of hand sanitizers, the seating arrangements for keeping clients at safe distances from each other and requiring medical and other staff to wear face masks all the time. We also require all people to wear face masks before they enter the Group’s clinics and service centres.

**Mr. Eddy Tang, Chairman, Executive Director and Chief Executive Officer of Union Medical Healthcare**, said, “Union Medical Healthcare is a leading integrated medical group in Greater China, providing individuals with quality professional medical services. The public medical system is overwhelmed by growing demand for medical services amid the epidemic. To alleviate the situation, the Group does its best by having its medical teams continue to provide professional services. The temporary suspension of its beauty services will affect its clients to a certain extent and will also inevitably affect the Group’s revenue. However, the Group’s operations other than the beauty services contributed to nearly 80% of the Group’s revenue so it expects the impact to be limited. At this critical moment, we will stand united in the fight against the epidemic. We hope the disease will die out soon.”
